4 - Your first Groove

YOUR FIRST GROOVE

Well done! You have now memorised the individual drums of the kit and are doing well in terms of coordination. It's time to start playing your first groove!

In principle, we now connect our three drum parts - bass drum, hi-hat, and snare drum - step by step.

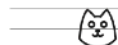
START WITH EXERCISE A:

Say 'WA-TER-ME-LON' loudly, over and over again. Start by giving each syllable a beat on the hi-hat. Once comfortable, add a beat on the bass drum to the first syllable ('WA'), along with the hi-hat.

Drums are also notated on a 'staff' consisting of five lines. These help you to distinguish and identify the different drums more easily.
